
California Surgeon General are leading ACEs Aware, a first-in-the-nation, statewide effort to implement screening for Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and treat toxic stress to improve the health and well-being of Californians. ACEs Aware offers clinical teams training, clinical protocols, and payment for screening

Seventy-nine percent of all screenings conducted were of members ages 0 to 20, 6% of whom had an ACE score of four or greater, indicating a high risk for toxic stress, and 21% of all screenings conducted were of members ages 21 to 64, 17% of whom had

Since the launch of the ACEs Aware initiative in December 2019, more than 42,240 individuals have completed the ACEs Aware core training, including approximately 19,990 Medi-Cal clinicians in California who are ACEs Aware-certified and eligible to receive Medi-Cal payment for conducting ACEs Aware is making a difference in clinical care.

practice based on the information presented in the training; 53% reported they plan to conduct routine ACE screenings for children; 48% reported they plan to conduct routine ACE screenings

for adults; and 90% reported being somewhat or very confident they would be able to make their intended practice changes. Additionally, 36% plan to change their treatment or management approach based on the patient's ACE score and toxic stress risk assessment, and 35% plan to apply a clinical algorithm on ACEs and toxic stress to guide patient care.


Percentage of Patients Screened Who Disclosed an ACE Score of 4 or More, Based on Medi-Cal Claims Data, by County



Adults (Ages 21 to 64): MCP clinicians screened 385,350 individuals, representing 5% of unique Medi-Cal members ages 21 through 64 who were enrolled with a single plan in any continuous 12-month period between January 1, 2020, and December 31, 2023 (and were not dually eligible for Medi-Cal and Medicare). 
